CHRONOLOGY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS IN SCRIPTURE

The following chronological listing shows the general flow of major events in the Bible. Although the events recorded by divine revelation are anchored in history it is not always possible to know the exact date of when they took place. Where dates are uncertain, particularly in the earlier centuries, approximate dates are given in order to maintain a reasonable chronological reference.¹
