## **Topical Study: The Holy Spirit**

God does not leave us alone on earth to somehow muddle along trying to live the Christian life. Even before Jesus ascended to Heaven He promised that God the Father would send us the Helper, who is the Holy Spirit (John 16:7; Acts 1:8). To consider the person and work of the Holy Spirit is to consider the awesomeness of God's presence and power in our lives.

1. The Holy Spirit is not a ghost, influence, or power. He is the third person of the Trinity. Consider what the following verses reveal about Who the Holy Spirit is and His divinity:
