- 6. What is the purpose of man? Genesis 1:28; Isaiah 43:7
- 7. Consider the Westminster Shorter Catechism's answer to the purpose of man: "Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy Him forever." Does this answer fit what the Bible says?

- 8. What does this answer (from #7 above) say about how you are to live your life? Deuteronomy 6:5; Ecclesiastes 12:13; Matthew 22:36-40
- 9. In the Garden of Eden Adam and Eve had a pure relationship with God. What changed and how? Genesis 3:1-7
- 10. Sin, by definition, is falling short of God's glory. We sin when we disobey God. Practically, sin is self-destructive behavior. Consider some of the consequences of sin:

 - Inability to comprehend the things of God: 1 Corinthians 2:14
 - Physical death: Genesis 3:19
 - Eternal punishment: Matthew 25:41; Revelation 20:11-15
