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WALKING IN LOVE

2 John 1:1-13

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What we believe always comes out in how we live. The place to begin authentically walking in love (in all our relationships) begins with loving God. What's in your heart? Are you personally trusting Jesus as your Savior?

It is important that we know the central truths of our faith. Take some time to read through the following passages and prayerfully think through the truths they teach. Ask God to help you understand what each means. Thank God for each one and the significance of His truth in your life.

- Inerrancy of Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:21
- Virgin birth and deity of Christ: Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:18-25; John 1:14; 8:53-58
- Sinless nature and life of Christ: Hebrews 4:15
- Substitutionary death of the Savior (Jesus dying in your place): Romans 5:6-8; 2 Corinthians 5:21
- Efficacy (or effectiveness) of Jesus' blood to wash away sin: Acts 20:28; Hebrews 9:22; 1 John 1:7
- Bodily resurrection of Christ from the grave: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11
- Ascension of Christ, and His present ministry in the believer: Ephesians 4:7-10; Hebrews 8:1-6
- Literal bodily return of Jesus to the earth (yet to occur): John 14:1-3; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

Being watchful does not mean disengaging from the world but learning to live authentic loving Christian lives in the world. Suggestion... This week ask God to give you opportunities to sacrificially love others. God may even use you to lead someone to a saving relationship with Jesus!
