How can your marriage glorify God?

The Bible affirms marriage and gives us guidelines as to what God's design for marriage is. Notably:

- I. Marriage is instituted and blessed by God Genesis 2:18-25; 17:1-21; 25:20-26; Ruth; Song of Solomon; John 2:1-11
- 2. Marriage is an exclusive relationship between a man and a woman

Genesis 1:26,27; 2:22-24; 1 Timothy 3:2,12; Titus 1:6

- 3. Scripture condemns sexual intercourse and marriage between any humans except a male and female married to each other Exodus 20:14; Leviticus 18:22; 20:13; Matthew 1:25; Acts 15:22-29; Romans 1:24-27; I Corinthians 6:9; 7:1,2; Ephesians 5:5; I Thessalonians 4:1-5; Hebrews 13:4
- 4. Marriage is ideally a partnership between believers
 I Corinthians 7:10-17; 2 Corinthians 6:14-18; Ephesians 5:30-33;
 I John 4:7-21
- 5. Marriage is a partnership Genesis 1:26-30; 2:18,23-25; 1 Corinthians 7:1-5; 11:3; Galatians 3:28; Ephesians 5:23,25,28,29
- 5. Marriage is a partnership that testifies of God's love Romans 5:8; 15:1-7; Ephesians 5:1,2,21-30; 1 John 4:8

Some suggestions for the development of a life-long-lasting marriage that will glorify God:

- Give God the first part of each day. Get up and pray in the morning. Mark 1:35
- 2. Give God the first day of each week. Worship, serve, grow, be active in the life ministry of His church | Corinthians 16:2; Hebrews 10:23-25
- 3. Give God the first portion of your income. Keep records of what you give to be sure that you're giving what you think you're giving.

Proverbs 3:9; Mark 12:41-44

 Give God the first consideration in every decision. This includes your choice of house, close friends, work, church, school, etc. Matthew 6:33
