### TAKING IT HOME...

Read through Philippians 3:4-6. Before he met Jesus, what was important to Paul? What was his goal in life?

Read Philippians 3:7-9. Since meeting Jesus, what is important to Paul now? What comparison does he make between what he had and what he now has in Jesus?

Read Philippians 3:10,11. What is Paul's goal now?

Read Philippians 3:12-16. What is Paul's attitude? How is he pursuing his goal?

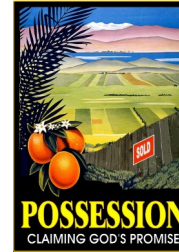
