3. These days, what is it like for you to listen to God's directions?

GOD'S PROMISE - verses 4-17

1. What does God's response reveal to you about God?
2. What might God's response mean to you personally?
3. How have you seen God at work in your life?
4. What does God's work in your life help you to understand about God?

DAVID'S RESPONSE - verses 18-29

1. What do these verses reveal about God?
2. What do these verses reveal about David's heart attitude towards God?
3. These days, how might David's response be an example and an encouragement to you?

PROCESSING ALL THAT...

Who God is and who we are:

1. It is easy to lose sight of Who God is - true or false? Why or why not?
2. How can knowing Who God is help us individually and as a congregation to glorify Him in our worship? Our love for each other? Our service?
3. How can knowing Who God is help you in the roles where God has called you to personally serve Him?
4. These days, what steps are you taking to deepen your understanding of Who God is?

Responding to God:

1. What difference can it make for you to know that God has personally chosen you for His great purposes?
2. What difference can it make for you to know that the circumstances you are in are not random?
3. These days, knowing that you are chosen and that your circumstances are not random, how will you respond to God?

SUPER BONUS QUESTION:

This week, what steps will you take to: 1) Spend time alone with God; 2) To deepen your understanding of Him and your relationship with Him; and 3) To worship and honor and praise Him?
