# "Easy" warm-up questions (choose one)

- 1. This past week, what have you seen God doing around you?
- 2. These days, what is God teaching you about Himself?

## "If then you have been raised with Christ..." 3:1-4

- 1. What does Paul tell the Colossian believers to do?
- 2. How is this (answer to #1) possible?
- 3. In verses 1 to 4, what stands out as being meaningful to you personally? Why?
- 4. These days, how does your answer to #3 effect the way you do life?
- 5. What in Paul's teaching (verses 1 to 4) can you personally give thanks to God for?

#### "Put to death therefore..." 3:5-11

- 1. What does Paul tell the Colossians to "put to death"? What does he mean by "put to death"?
- 2. How is it possible for us to put these things to death?
- 3. How is putting these things to death a part of our conversion and repentance?
- 4. These days, what does being able to put these things to death look like for you personally?
- 5. What in Paul's teaching (verses 5 to 11) can you personally give thanks to God for?

#### "Put on then ... " 3:12-14

- 1. What does Paul tell the Colossians to "put on then"? What does he mean by "put on then"?
- 2. How is it possible for us to put on then these things?
- 3. How is putting on these things a part of our conversion and repentance?
- 4. These days, what does being able to put on these things look like for you personally?
- 5. What in Paul's teaching (verses 12-14) can you personally give thanks to God for?

## "And let the peace of Christ rule..." 3:15-17

- 1. How is the "peace of Christ" related to Paul's instruction to "be thankful"?
- 2. How is letting "the word of Christ dwell in you richly" related to Paul's instruction to "be thankful"?
- 3. How does all of this (answers to #'s 1 & 2) relate to Paul's instruction in verse 17 to give *"thanks to God the Father through Him"* (Jesus)?
- 4. What in Paul's teaching (verses 15 to 17) can you personally give thanks to God for?

#### Processing all that...

- 1. Think back as a group to what you've shared and take time as a group to pray and praise and thank God for all that He has done for you especially those realities that Paul has focused on in this teaching.
- 2. Moving forward (i.e. *"It's Sunday and Monday is coming."*), what will you do to keep in mind the truths shared in this teaching and to remain thankful?
