Paul's Reason For Praying 1:15,16

- 1. By God's grace, with seemingly everything going for them and as they were "on fire" living and loving for God, why would Paul need to pray for the Ephesian Christians?
- It is harder to faithfully follow God when things are going wrong than when things are going right.

God's Presence (verse 17)

1. Wisdom comes from understanding more of what God is doing and knowing more about God.

- 3. How is God's power effectively applied to and through our lives?
