- 2. How does Abram's response demonstrate the difference between true repentance and merely feeling sorry for our sin and its consequences?
- 3. How did God respond to Abram? Did Abram deserve this response?
- 4. In thinking through why God responded to Abram the way He did, what does Lamentations 3:22,23 reveal about the character of God?
- 5. What does Philippians 4:19,20 reveal about why God responded to Abram the way He did?
- 6. Assuming that we all mess up, how has God responded to you when you've turned to Him?

- 8. Have you ever experienced circumstances similar to what Abram and Lot were experiencing?

- 13. How does Lot's answer demonstrate faith in himself?

## Extra Credit

- 16. In Ecclesiastes King Solomon writes of how he has examined everything that we might consider valuable (might put our trust in). What are the test results (advice) that he shares in Ecclesiastes 12:13,14?
- 17. How does Solomon's advice demonstrate an understanding of Who God is and why He is to be feared and obeyed (trusted with our lives)?
- 18. These days, what does following Solomon's advice look like in your life?
