- 1. Do you think that Abraham adequately answered Abimelech's question? Why or why not?
- Based on Abraham's answer, what was Abraham's first step towards failure?
- 3. How might understanding the answer to the above question help you to avoid sinning?

Abimelech's Generosity (verses 14-16)

1. What does Abimelech's generosity tell you about God?

God's Restoration (verses 17,18)

1. How might God's response to Abraham be an encouragement to you?

Processing all that...

- 1. Often when we enter a new circumstance of life our old patterns of sin show up and we need to learn again the lessons of faith. God, in His grace, has moved us to new applications of old lessons. How have you seen God do this in your life?
- 2. Often, when we fall into old patterns of sin it is because the root causes of that sin have not yet been dealt with. How might what we've seen in this chapter help you to let God deal with those deeper root causes of sin in your life?
