- 1. What do these verses help you to understand about God?
- 2. What does Abraham's response help you to understand about trusting God?

The Problem of Ishmael (verses 8-21)

- 1. What was the choice that confronted Abraham?
- 2. How did Abraham respond to God?
- 3. What is Plan A? What is Plan B?
- 4. These days, does your relationship with God look more like Plan A or Plan B? How is that going for you?
- 5. What do these verses help you to understand about God that might help you to follow Plan A?

Abraham's Covenant with Abimelech (verses 22-32)

- 1. In what ways is Abraham's encounter with Abimelech different than his previous encounter in Genesis 20? How do Abraham's actions demonstrate his growing trust in God?
- 2. How might Abraham's actions in chapter 21 be an example for you to follow in trusting God?

Abraham's Heart (verses 33,34)

- 1. Where is Abraham living?
- 2. In the midst of the desert and surrounded by Philistines, what do Abraham's actions in these verses demonstrate about his heart level understanding of God?
- 3. These days, in the places where you "do life" what would it look like for you to "plant a tamarisk tree" and to call on the name of the Lord, the Everlasting God?

Processing all that...

1. John 6:66-71 reminds us that even Jesus' disciples chose to go with Plan B. These days, what from this study will help you to stay on Plan A?

- 2. What characterizes the "oneness" that Jesus is praying for?
- 3. What is the source of that "oneness"?
- 4. How is "oneness" with Jesus and the Church dependent on our individually/collectively following Plan A?
- 5. In what ways is this group intentionally working to create the quality of oneness that Jesus prayed for?
- 6. As a group, how might we take our efforts to "the next level"?
