





- 1. What kinds of experiences have you had with *"signs and wonders"* (i.e. miracles and demonstrations of God's power)?
- 2. In what ways can you relate to where this father is coming from?
- 3. What do you think of Jesus' response to this father (verse 48)? "Unless you (plural) see signs and wonders you (plural) will not believe."
- 4. How do you respond when God doesn't do what you want Him to do?
- 5. How does Jesus' response meet the deeper needs of the father?
- 6. What does the father receive from Jesus?
- 7. How is this different than what the father was originally asking for?
- 8. How are the servants effected by this? The household? The son?
- 9. Have you ever received more from Jesus than you asked for?
- 10. Compare what Jesus says about signs in verse 48 with what John writes about signs (his theme verse) in John 20:30,31. How do these two passages relate to each other?
- 11. What does it mean to "believe" in the sense of verse 53 and John 20:31?
- 12. How might this study change what you pray for?
- 13. How might this study change how you respond when God answers your prayer?
- 14. Ultimately, what do you expect of Jesus?
