Easy warm-up questions (choose one)

1. What was the best or worst Super Bowl commercial you've seen?
2. What was the best or worst Super Bowl play or call?

The Question - Where Jesus is going as He concludes His teaching (verse 46)

1. Respect is always earned. AGREE DISAGREE
2. How are listening and respect tied to obedience?
3. In your own words, what is the question Jesus asks?
4. In asking the question (verse 46), what is Jesus working to get His disciples to realize about themselves?
5. How might we make wrong assumptions about how Jesus is calling us to follow Him?

The Choice - Jesus' illustration (verses 47-49)

1. In your own words, what is Jesus' illustration?
2. Each of us is given a choice of foundations upon which to build our lives. What are these two choices?
3. There are only two choices of foundations. TRUE FALSE
4. It is possible to assume we are listening and "building" on Jesus when in fact we are "listening" and building on Satan's lies. AGREE DISAGREE
5. Why is Jesus the only authority we can trust with our lives? How would you make the case for this to someone who disagrees?

Processing all that...

1. These days, what does it look like for you to come to Jesus as Jesus calls you to come to Him?
2. These days, in what ways do you struggle with coming to Jesus as He calls you (and all of us) to come?
3. These days, what does it look like for you to hear Jesus?
4. These days, what steps are you taking to hear Him more clearly?
5. These days, what does it look like for you to obey Jesus?
6. These days, what steps are you taking to live more obediently to what Jesus says to you?
7. Ultimately, what does all of the above have to do with what it means to be a true disciple of Jesus?

Going farther...

1. This week (and probably longer than that) what difference will this section of Jesus' teaching make in how you relate to God and others?
