2. Consider Jesus' statement of truth in verse 27.
3. What is Jesus trying to get the disciples to understand?
4. Why is it important for us to understand Jesus' point?
5. These days, when do you find yourself trying to do the "impossible"?
6. These days, what might you need to do in order to let God do what is only "possible" for Him to do?

## IT'S NOT ABOUT THE SACRIFICE - 10:28-31

1. If it's not about the sacrifice what is it about? Why?
2. Have you ever felt like you were sacrificing more than others?
3. Have you ever wondered if the "return" on your sacrifice was worth the sacrifice?
4. These days, what in the reassuring examples that Jesus shares with Peter is especially meaningful to you?
5. In verse 31, who's first and who's last?
6. In verse 31, what's Jesus point?
7. Consider your priorities in how you are approaching life. These days, would you say that your priorities are more focused on being first or being last?
