1. Identify who each person/group represents.
2. Which person/group do you find most easy to personally identify with? Why?
3. What is the main point of Jesus' parable?
4. Is there any part of Jesus' parable that strikes you as unusual? Strange? Troubling?
5. These days, what part of Jesus' parable/teaching resonates with you the most? Why?
6. What does Jesus' parable help you to understand about Jesus?
7. These days, why is it important for you to know this about Jesus?

1. What in this passage struck you as especially meaningful? Why?
2. These days, how might understanding the truth taught here help you to live without fear?
3. In the days ahead, what changes might you make based on this study?
