- 1. Who were the Scribes?
- 2. By His question in verse 35, is Jesus insinuating that the Christ is *not* in any sense the son of David? What exactly is He asking?
- 3. From the first part of verse 36 (*"David himself, in the Holy Spirit, declared..."*), what do we learn about how Jesus viewed the Old Testament? Why is it helpful for you to know this?
- 4. What was the significance of Jesus quoting Psalm 110:1?
- 5. In verse 37, what was the question Jesus asked?
- 6. What was Jesus' reason for asking the question?
- 7. As a group make a list of the five most important truths concerning Who Jesus is. Give at least one Scripture reference to validate each truth.
- 8. These days, which truth is the most meaningful to you? Why?

THE WARNING 12:38-40

- 1. Jesus gives examples of the Scribes' sin. What are they?
- 2. What do these sins look like when Christians do them?
- 3. Which one seems to nail you more than the others? How/why?
- 4. What does Jesus say is the consequence for someone acting as the Scribes?
- 5. Consider Romans 8:1-4. What is God's answer to our sin?
