PRAYER AT GETHSEMANE 14:32-42

1. What might have been the reason(s) Jesus took His disciples to Gethsemane?
2. Struggling with the will of God is sin: TRUE FALSE
3. The temptation to avoid following God's will is sin: TRUE FALSE
4. What was it that Jesus struggled with?
5. What does this struggle help you to understand about Jesus?
6. These days, how might the example of Jesus' struggles and choices be of help to you?

1. Of the different people at Gethsemane, whom do you identify yourself most with? Why?
2. In what ways were the actions of those arresting Jesus shameful and/or absurd?
3. Was Peter's ear slicing bravado appropriate and/or understandable and/or misguided? Why?
4. Consider how Jesus responds to Judas, those arresting Him, and Peter (along with Malchus). What do you learn about Jesus from His responses?
5. How might Jesus' actions help you to trust Him more?

2. Why does Mark include himself in the narrative?
3. Why is it helpful for you to know this?
