REALLY EASY WARM-UP QUESTIONS

- 1. Have you ever been "between a rock and a hard place"? What were the circumstances and what did you do about it?
- 2. Or, determine who can say the following the fastest: "Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers. A peck of pickled peppers Peter Piper picked. If Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers, where's the peck of pickled peppers Peter Piper picked?"

PILATE'S PREQUEL 15:1

- 1. What is significant about the time and location of the Sanhedrin's "consultation"?
- 2. Why was it important for the Sanhedrin to hold this "consultation" before taking Jesus to Pilate?

PILATE'S PERSPECTIVE 15:2-5

- 1. What are Pilate's responsibilities as the Roman Procurator of Judea?
- 2. How did the Sanhedrin embellish their accusation (cf. Luke 23:2b)? Why?
- 3. As the Sanhedrin piled on accusation after accusation Jesus remained silent. Why?
- 4. How did Jesus' response affect Pilate? Why? (HINT: If Jesus was a "would be" insurrectionist Messiah like all the others, how might He have responded to Pilate?)

- 1. What was Pilate's problem?
- How did the Sanhedrin (and crowd) add to Pilate's problem?

PILATE'S PROPOSAL 15:9-14

- 1. Why do you think the crowd responded with such hatred for Jesus?
- 2. Why do you think Pilate underestimated the hatred of the Sanhedrin for Jesus?

PILATE'S PUNT 15:15

- How did Pilate punt?
- 2. Why did Pilate punt?

PROCESSING ALL THAT...

- 1. What does it mean that they've got the wrong man on trial?
- 2. These days, what does it mean for you to know that Jesus isn't on trial for Himself, but for you? (consider also 1 Peter 3:18)
- These days, what does it mean for you to know that Jesus "gets" you? (consider also Hebrews 4:14-16)
