## **BONUS QUESTIONS**

- 1. Jesus saw in the disciples much more than they saw in themselves. He saw beyond where they were to what they would become. What does it mean for you to know that Jesus sees more potential in you than you are personally aware of yourself?
- 2. Where does Jesus find you today? As you think about your answer to the question consider that God sees your life both inside and out. He knows what you struggle with and what you desire others to know about you. He knows your past and your future. He knows where you do life and what that life is like for you. Be honest, where are you at?
- 3. What does God's call look like in your life? Put another way, what is God's purpose for your life that transcends every area of your life?
- 4. These days, how are you doing at yielding to God? Put another way, these days what does your response to God's call on your life look like?
