# LEVI - verses 13-15

- 1. What do these verses help you to understand about Levi?
- 2. Mark and Luke record essentially the same call and response, but refer to Matthew as Levi (Mark 2:13-17; Luke 5:27-32). In his gospel account Levi refers to himself as Matthew (meaning "gift of God") which was a name probably given to him by Jesus (Matthew 9:9-13). Why might Levi refer to himself as Matthew?
- 3. What impresses you about Levi's response to Jesus?
- 4. These days, what does it look like for you to respond to Jesus as Levi did?

- 4. These days, how might your attitude be similar to that of the Scribes and Pharisees?

### JESUS - verse 17

- 1. What does verse 17 help you to understand about Jesus?
- 2. How is Jesus' purpose statement in verse 17 consistent with His message in Mark 1:15?
- 3. What was Jesus' attitude toward Levi? The Scribes of the Pharisees? The guests at Levi's house?
- 4. These days, what are you doing to grow in having the same attitude Jesus demonstrates in these verses?

### PROCESSING ALL THAT...

- 1. As a former "tax collector", these days, what does it mean for you to know that God sees you as being created in His image?
- 2. Who are the tax collectors in your life? Who are the sick people?
- 3. What might it mean for them to also understand that they are created in the image of God?
- 4. How will you share that truth with them?

- 1. These days, do you think Creekside's "attitude" is more like Levi, the Scribes of the Pharisees, or Jesus?
