- 1. Who is the "one man" that Paul is writing about in verse 12? How do we know this?
- 2. What does it mean that "sin came into the world through one man"? How is this possible?
- 3. What does Paul mean by death?
- 4. How has "death spread to all men"? How is this possible? Is this fair?
- 5. Who is "the one who was to come"?
- 6. How is Adam "a type" of Christ?
- 7. Thinking about what your life is like, how do you experience the reign of death in this world?

God Offers Us Life (verses 15-17)

- 8. Consider how Paul describes Adam and Jesus. What are the similarities? What are the differences?
- 9. Both Adam and Jesus made a moral choice. What was that choice? (c.f. Luke 22:42)
- 10. How does Paul contrast the effect of their choices?
- 11. How has the choice of each impacted humanity? Closer to home... how has the choice of each impacted those you rub shoulders with each day?
- 12. Compare the two clauses: "death reigned" and "those who receive... will reign." What are the differences between the two?
- 13. How does what Paul describes (the reality of what he is comparing and contrasting between Adam and Jesus) have an impact on your life?

We Can Choose Life (verses 18-21)

- 14. Verses 20,21 are the summary/concluding point of Paul's teaching in this section (1:18-5:21). What is his primary point?
- 15. What does it mean to you personally to know this truth?
- 16. What could the reign of life in Christ look like for you as you live out each day?
- 17. What could the reign of life in Christ look like for those around you?
- 18. If you had to pick just one insight from this study that speaks specifically to you, what would it be? Why? How do you plan to respond to it?
