Where Paul is going... (verse 15)

1. What does it mean to be “under law”?
2. What does it mean to be “under grace”?
3. These days what does it mean to you to be “under grace” verses being “under law”?

Sin Enslaves Us - Grace Frees Us (verses 16-19)

1. How does sin enslave us?
2. How does grace free us?
3. We all serve someone or something; it's just a question of who or what. Who or what do you think enslaves most people these days?
4. These days how are you experiencing freedom in Christ?

Sin Produces Shame - Grace Produces Fruit (verses 20,21a)

1. How does sin produce shame?
2. How does grace produce fruit?
3. These days where do you see the fruit of grace being produced in your life?

Sin Demands Death - Grace Gives Life (verses 21b-23)

1. How does Paul contrast what we earn by sin and what we are given by grace?
2. What difference does it make to you knowing that you have eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord?

Processing all that...

1. Is it possible to be a slave to something and think you are free?
2. Is it possible to be free and think you are enslaved?
3. How does the truth that Paul shares here provide a remedy for both of these struggles (questions 1 & 2)?
4. How can we embrace the freedom that is ours in Jesus?
