THE WAY

1. Jesus' claim to be the Way was a life-altering claim that shocked the Pharisees. Why was this claim so monumental?
2. Find three other passages in Scripture that support the idea that Jesus is the only way to the Father.
3. How are believers affected by the fact that Jesus is the Way to the Father?
4. Why do we need a Way to the Father?

THE TRUTH

1. How does it impact our lives when we have truth that is not relative?
2. In your own life, when has truth become relative? What was the outcome?
3. What does it mean to you that Jesus died on the cross and gave His own life to bridge the gap of sin?
4. Why is it so important that humanity cannot bridge the gap on their own but must rely upon Jesus to bridge the gap for us?

THE LIFE

1. In 2 Corinthians 5:21, it says that Jesus has taken our sin and put it on Himself, why was this so important?
2. Also in 2 Corinthians 5:21, what does it mean that "in Him we become the righteousness of God"?
3. How does the cross affect nonbelievers?
4. How does the cross affect believers?
5. Being saved from hell is not the main point of accepting Jesus, what is the main point then?

EXCEPT THROUGH ME

1. What interactions with nonbelievers have shown you the distortions of who people believe Jesus to be?
2. Have you noticed in your own life any ways you have believed incorrect theology of who Jesus is?
3. Do you agree that Christians have no excuse for understanding who Jesus is?
4. Why?

PROCESSING ALL OF THAT...

1. Do you truly believe that Jesus is the way, the truth, the life, and that none can reach the Father except through Him? Why?
2. When we read the Nicene Creed in the Service of Worship, what did you like about the Creed?

BONUS QUESTIONS

1. Read the Apostles Creed, how did this Creed shape what the Evangelical Church believes?
2. What does this study reveal to you about God's will and desire for you?
